BeOnePage supports the WordPress Custom Menus feature, you can create and arrange a group of navigation links for your visitors to find the important parts of your site faster. BeOnePage allows you to have 2 Custom Menus: **Header Menu** in theme's header and **Social Menu** in theme's footer. To set up your navigation menus, go to **Appearances -> Menus**. Also, you can manage your menus directly from the WordPress Customizer (**Appearances -> Customize -> Menus**).




If you want to create jump links (also known as anchor links) that take you to a specific module of the Front Page, you need use **Custom** 

Links box to add the jump link to your menu items. Instead of putting a full URL, simply type the number
sign (#) followed by the word you set
for the Module ID, like this:
