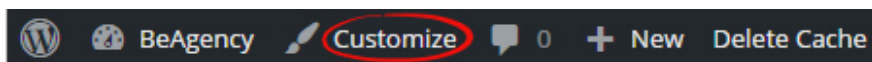

### Customizing 404 Page

The 404 page serves as a quickly recognizable message that displays when your server is unable to find a page your visitor is requesting. It is most commonly displayed as the result of a broken or dead link. BeAgency includes a simple 404 error page. This article will show you how to edit the custom text on the 404 page.

1. Go to a 404 page on your site, e.g., <http://yoursite.com/404/>.
2. Launch the **WordPress Customizer** from **Admin Bar**.



3. Click 404 Page. Customize the text in real time.
