

One of the first steps you will take when setting up your site is adding your own site icon and logo. It's easy to upload your icon and logo from the Theme Customizer: **Appearance -> Customize -> Icon & Logo**.



- **Site Icon**. The Site Icon (also known as favicon) is used as a browser and app icon for your site. Icons must be square, and at least 512px wide and tall.
- Logo Type. You can keep not only to use the default text logo but also to upload your own custom image logo and retina image logo if needed.
- Regular Logo. The Regular Logo image's maximum height must be 100px.
- Retina Logo. The Retina Logo is displayed on devices that
 have a higher than normal pixel density. Using this option will
 ensure that your logo looks great on all devices (e.g., iPad with
 retina display). The Retina Logo should be uploaded at exactly double the dimensions of your regular logo. So if your
 regular logo is 200×100 then your retina logo would be

400×200.
